Dear Team Captain:

Thank you for engaging your company and being part of the 2017 Mercedes-Benz Corporate Run. This Captain packet contains your souvenir t-shirts, race numbers with timing chip, pins, course map, green seeded runner and red Concrete Beach beer wristbands.

We hope the haku registration system made it easy to sign up your company's participants. Be sure to share the link to your team page with your participants so they can post pictures and comments leading up to and after the Race. You'll find the link in Captain's Tools on the Team Captains Central page. This same team page will show your race results. Now might be a good time to save the link to access it from your smartphone or tablet on race night.

CATERING: Catering orders are due by 5:00PM on April 21st. Using our official caterer, Game Plan, is a no-fuss turnkey solution. Just show up and your food and beverages will be delivered to your team tent. Menu is available at MercedesBenzCorporateRun.com.

BEFORE RACE DAY: Look for the race numbers in your packet. Notice that each person's name is printed on the number along with their shirt size. Distribute the race numbers, shirts and pins to the appropriate person. Make sure each person is given the number assigned to them. Each person must wear the number assigned to them.

RACE NUMBERS: Each participant has been assigned an official race number. Do not lose this number. Treat it like your ticket to the event. Without your ticket, you won't be able to participate. There is a \$10 fee for lost race number replacement. Race numbers must be worn on the front of the shirt or shorts. **DO NOT FOLD OR BEND THE NUMBER, OR TAMPER WITH THE TIMING CHIP!**

RACE DAY: Hand out the seeded runner wrist bands to your fastest team members on race day. Do not do this before race day. Lost or forgotten wristbands will not be replaced. The starting corrals are on Biscayne Blvd, from Chopin Plaza and extends back to NE 3rd St. **PLEASE STAY OUT OF THE START AREA UNTIL INSTRUCTED**. Once given the go ahead, CEOs wearing a TD Bank CEO Competition number and runners wearing the green seeded runner wristbands line up in the first corral, runners behind them, and walkers behind the runners. The race will start at 6:45pm with the boom of our signal cannon!

RACE FINISH: The finish is on Biscyane Blvd. and NE 3rd Street. **ENCOURAGE YOUR PARTICIPANTS TO CONTINUE MOVING THROUGH THE CHUTE AND NOT STOP AT THE FINISH LINE.**

POST-RACE REFRESHMENTS: Light post-race refreshments will be provided. In your packet you will find red Concrete Beach Brewery wristbands for every team member 21 and over. Participants will be able to redeem these for one free Concrete Beach beer at the sampling tent after the race. Race staff will cut the wristbands off once you receive the beer. One beer per wristband, one wristband per participant. ID's will be checked at the beer sampling tent, make sure only team members 21 and older get a wristband.

RACE RESULTS & SCORING: Finish times will be found on the team page on race night. Team Captains must log onto Captain's Tools and submit their scores by 5pm Monday, May 1st in order to compete with other teams in their industry category. The winning teams will be posted on the event's website Tuesday, May 2nd. Race Results book will be mailed to Team Captains by the end of May.

AWARDS: Awards will be given on race night to the overall fastest male and female, fastest male and female in the TD Bank CEO Competition, T-Shirt Contest Winners, and the largest team. Medals are mailed to the winning team in each industry category.









































HOW TO GET THERE

Parking and driving near Bayfront Park after 2:00PM on Thursday, April 27th will be very difficult due to: the 28,000+ participants trying to make their way to the Park, the normal Downtown traffic trying to make their way out, and the City of Miami Police closing and re-routing streets in preparation for the Race. The following are our suggestions to make your Miami Mercedes-Benz Corporate Run experience as smooth and hassle-free as possible:

USE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Take the Metrorail to the Govenment Center Station and transfer to either the Metromover Inner or Omni Loop. Alternatively, take the Metrorail to the Brickell Station and transfer to the Metromover Brickell Loop. Take the Metromover to either the First Street Station or College/Bayside Station and walk two blocks east to Bayfront Park. The Metromover is FREE to ride.

Make Your Race Day Experience a Smooth One: Round Trip Metrorail tickets are available for purchase from TeamFootWorks while supplies last.

DRIVE YOUR CAR

If you must drive your car to the Miami Mercedes-Benz Corporate Run, we ask that you carpool. Parking is available in City lots (normal parking rates apply) and Bayside Marketplace (\$5 when you show your race number and FREE to team captains using the enclosed Bayside parking pass). Consider driving to the Omni garage and taking the free Metromover to the College/Bayside or First Street stations. The park is two blocks east of these stations. The police will begin closing down streets at 2:00PM. The I-95 exits into Downtown will be extremely congested. All northbound lanes on Biscayne Blvd between Chopin and NE 4 St will be closed at 6:00PM.

DROPPING OFF SUPPLIES FOR YOUR TEAM TENT

Look for an e-mail with the designated drop off areas one week prior to the event. The four Drop Off Zones will be on Biscayne Blvd between Chopin and NE 2nd St. The Drop Off period will be from 11AM to 2:00PM. You must bring a teammate, the car cannot be left unattended. Volunteers will unload and deliver the items to your team tent. The event is not responsible for loss or damage. One person must accompany the volunteer and remain with the tent items at all times. The other person must immediately move the vehicle out of the Drop Off Zone by driving NORTH on Biscayne Blvd. After 2:00PM, the race site will be closed off for deliveries. No outside tables, chairs, tents, furniture can be brought into the Park. We recommend using the event's official caterer to make it easier for you next year.
